

## Who are FOCCUS Facilitators and Trainers?

FOCCUS Facilitators can be clergy, lay individuals, mentor couples as well as professionals such as therapists or adult educators.

FOCCUS Trainers are experienced FOCCUS Facilitators who received additional training to become certified to teach others to properly use the FOCCUS Inventory.

## Requirements to be a FOCCUS Facilitator or Trainer?

In order to become a FOCCUS Facilitator, one must participate in a training session administered by a Certified FOCCUS Trainer or complete the online training. All Facilitators must agree to properly use the FOCCUS Inventory and register with FOCCUS, Inc. USA.

To become a FOCCUS Trainer of Facilitators, additional training by a FOCCUS Certified International Trainer is required along with:

- ◆ verification of FOCCUS facilitation with 10 Couples over the course of at least two years;
- ◆ letters of recommendation from two couples;
- ◆ completion of an application and agreement form describing background and experience; and
- ◆ payment of the trainer application fee.

The FOCCUS Manager will follow up with a phone call to welcome you and answer any additional questions. Once your trainer interview is complete a trainer packet is mailed with the required FOCCUS PowerPoint and hand-out materials for individualized trainings within your organization.

## REFOCCUS

FOCCUS Training also includes information about the REFOCCUS© Marriage Enrichment Inventory which can be completed online or self scored using the QuickScore and pencil-paper. Intended for couples who have been married for more than two years, REFOCCUS does not require a trained Facilitator. The REFOCCUS Facilitator Manual offers detailed information for facilitators and options for use of REFOCCUS with individual couples and groups of couples in both general and specialized settings.
